

Sycamore Canyon



Directions to the Park

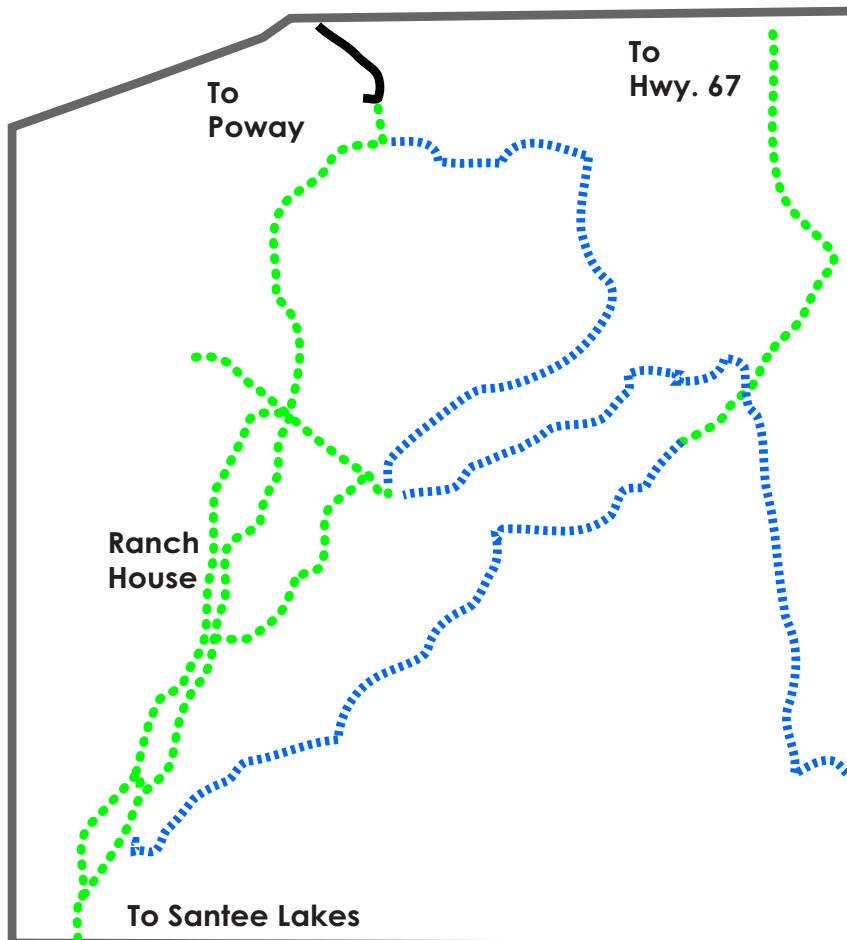
There are two entrances to Sycamore Canyon. The best is to use the park entrance off of Hwy. 67. Take Hwy. 67 The entrance will be on the west side of the highway. You must be careful, because the park entrance comes up suddenly and is not well marked. It is okay to park at the gate when it is closed.

You may also enter the park from Sycamore Canyon Dr. Take I-15 or Hwy. 67 to Poway Rd. Take Poway Rd. to Garden Rd. Take Garden Rd. East until you cross Sycamore Canyon Rd. Take Sycamore Canyon Rd. south until it dead-ends in the park. This parking lot is open daily.

Best Route:

Start at the Hwy. 67 parking lot or gate. Follow the trail from the southern end of the parking lot. After about a mile the trail will drop into the valley. At the valley floor, go right to the south gate of the park. You will have to cross the creek, go over a horse gate, and then cross back over so you are on the valley trail again. Follow this to the windmill and take a right onto the eastern singletrack. Follow this until it hits a road. Take a left on the road and follow it to an intersection. At the intersection, the western singletrack is off to the left. Follow this back down to the southern end of the park.

Return up the valley trail. At the windmill, go straight and ride through the ranch house area. Continue along this road and climb the hill to the Sycamore Canyon Rd. parking lot. At the parking lot you will see a trail heading up the hill to the east. Take this trail to Martha's Grove. From Martha's Grove, follow the trail back to the road. At the road turn left and climb back up to the parking lot.
